- Get familiar with AUSMUN rules of procedure.

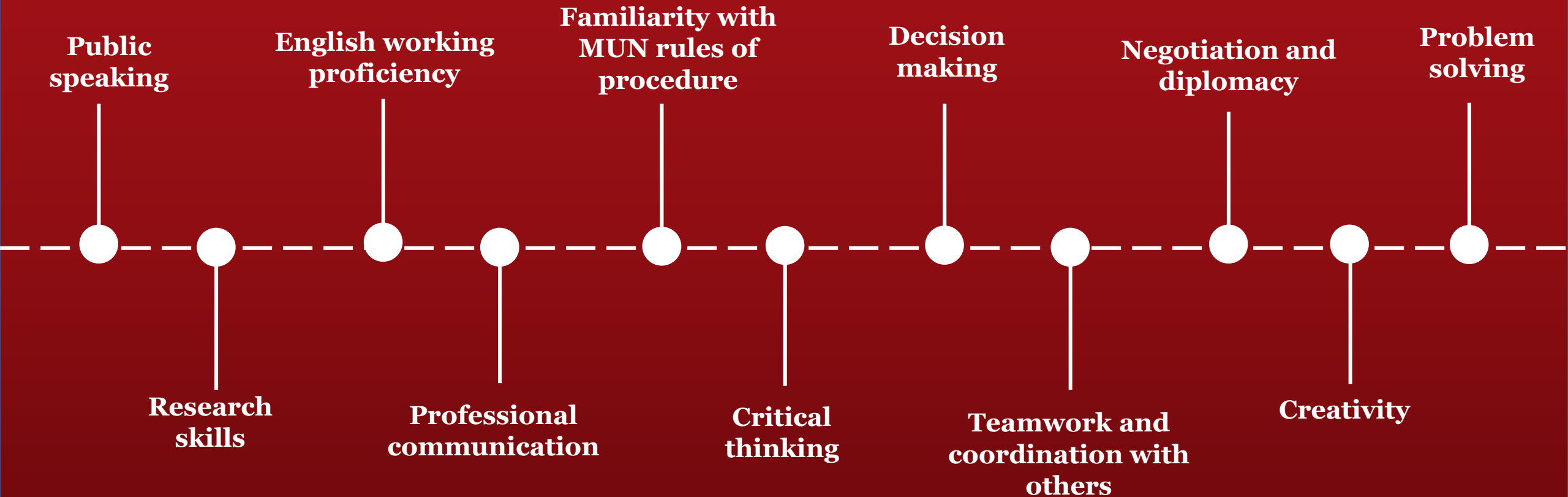
WRITING:

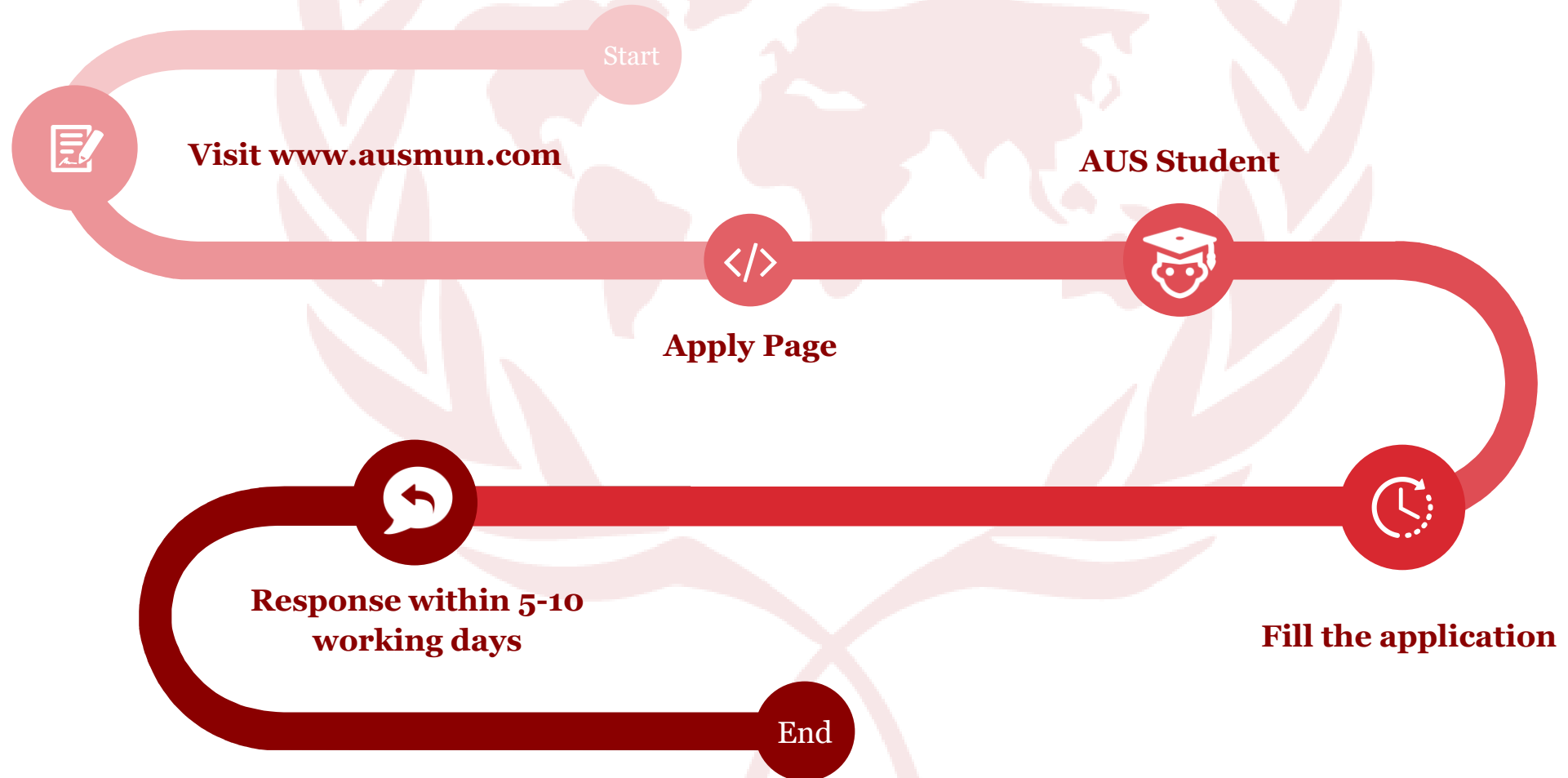

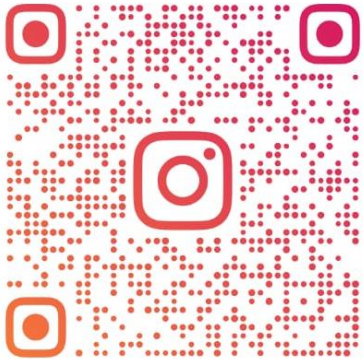
